

TIGER 2 Projects

The projects listed below are being funded with grants of around £7,000 from the Tiger 2 programme to enable small groups and excluded people in the most disadvantaged wards across the East Midlands to run activities that develop local social capital and provide opportunities for learning. CEFET is the intermediary body managing Tiger 2, which is funded by Objective 2 ESF and the Learning and Skills Council.

NOTTINGHAM Tiger 2 Projects

Project name: **Fashion and Basic Skills**

Community Group: **Meadows Women's Learning Platform**

To involve women from BME communities in the Meadows area in activities that build their skills, improve their social connections and confidence and encourage them to voice their opinions in the regeneration plans for the area. They have asked for sewing classes and help with English.

Project name: **Migrant Support**

Community Group: **Migrant Support**

The project will train 15 migrants in the legal issues around immigration and support them to set up an advice service for their different communities.
